

The University of Chicago will provide free flu shots at several University locations for active, benefits-eligible faculty, staff, and other academic position (OAP) employees, beginning Monday November 5, 2007. These are walk-in locations; no appointment is necessary. New this year, flu shots will be available during the Employee Benefits Health Fair on:

****November 13th, 10:00 am - 3:00 pm; Ida Noyes Hall - Cloister Club****

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

Free flu shots are available to active, benefits-eligible University of Chicago employees, UHRM Temporary Pool employees and faculty. Family members, retirees, students and temporary employees from an agency are NOT eligible, due to a limited supply of vaccine.

If you are not eligible for this employee benefit, you may obtain a flu shot for a fee through your regular healthcare provider, or through neighborhood pharmacies such as Walgreens, CVS and Osco and retailers with pharmacies such as Dominicks, Target and Wal-Mart.

HOW DOES THIS WORK:

At each site you will complete the *Influenza Vaccine Record 2007-2008* and remember --

POSSIBLE ADVERSE EFFECTS:

- Soreness at site of injection for one to two days (somewhat common)
- Fever and achiness for one to two days (very rare)
- Life-threatening allergic reactions, usually in persons allergic to eggs (extremely rare)
- Guillain-Barré syndrome, an acute paralytic illness (extremely rare, if at all)
